The co-coordinating teacher is Charlotte Kewley. The staff will be carrying a mobile phone to be used if needed for contact with the group, or for calling assistance in an emergency. There will be first aid available at the school at all times.

You may wish to consider taking out personal insurance cover for yourself and/or for students and non-enrolled children accompanying the excursion.
