Dear families

We are seeking your support for the school in two important ways, Voluntary Financial Contributions and volunteering your time.

Voluntary Financial Contributions

Each year the School Board recommends the amount of money we ask families to give as voluntary contributions. This money goes into specific curriculum budgets and plays a vital role in enhancing the range of engaging educational programs offered for all children, from preschool to year 6.

School Library Fund

You can ask for your voluntary contribution to go to the School Library Fund. This is a Designated Gift Recipient (DGR) recognised by the Australian Taxation Office and the money is tax deductible. This money will be used to purchase resources for the library. Businesses can make tax free donations so if you, your family or friends own a business, they may like to donate to the School Library fund.

How much in 2020?

The School Board has proposed a voluntary contribution amount of

- 🌸 \$70.00 for an individual student, or
- 🌸 \$100.00 for a family of two or more students.

This is not a set amount. You may give this amount, or a larger or smaller amount. We appreciate any amount you can contribute. All contributions are voluntary, and your payment details are confidential. Your child will not miss out or be refused benefits if you do not choose to contribute (this commitment is also reflected through *The Education Act 2004*).

Volunteering your time

There is always plenty happening at school and we invite families to volunteer two hours of their time each term.
