Dear families,

From Term 3 Margaret Hendry School will transition from the SchoolTalk platform to Seesaw (<http://seesaw.me>), a secure online journal where children can document and reflect on what they are learning in their communities.

### HOW DOES SEESAW WORK?

Seesaw allows children to use creative tools to take pictures, draw, record videos and more to capture learning in a portfolio. Learning coaches will be able to share information, photos, videos and documents about learning experiences with families and allows feedback from both peers and learning coaches. Families get notified when there are new posts in their child's journal. They only see their child's work and can leave comments and encouragement.

Scan the QR code on the left to watch a short video introducing you to Seesaw.

In order for your child to use Seesaw, the app needs your child's name and student ID number to associate work like their photos, videos or voice recordings with their account. Seesaw only uses this information to provide the service and doesn't advertise in Seesaw, create profiles of students, or share or sell your child's personal information or journal content. In Week 1 of Term 3 you will receive instructions on how to join your child's SEESAW journal. This can only be sent out after permission has been granted to add your child to the Seesaw platform. Should you choose not to give permission for your child to use Seesaw your child will be in no way disadvantaged. Our learning coaches will always ensure that suitable alternatives are available.
