



Dear Parents and Carers

Remote learning for year 3-6 children commencing, Thursday (tomorrow) 05/05/2022 – Tuesday 10/05/2022 inclusive.

I'd like to thank all of our families, children and staff for the way you've supported one another during this school year. As with all parts of the ACT community, we have been challenged by the impact of COVID-19 on our school operations.

Since the start of term 2, we have experienced limited availability of staff primarily due to staff isolating with COVID-19 or as household contacts.

As a result, we have unfortunately reached a point where we are unable to run normal face to face learning programs.

Transition to remote learning period year 3-6 children

Guided by the ACT Education Directorate COVID Staffing Matrix, we are temporarily transitioning to remote learning for children in years 3-6 within each learning community **starting tomorrow** 05/05/2022. We anticipate that your child will be able to resume face to face learning Wednesday 11/05/2022.

Remote learning program for year 3-6 children

During this time, children will access their learning via Seesaw. Your child will still be greeted by their learning coach each day. Learning coaches will provide instructions, including times for Google meetings on Seesaw. Children will then be able to independently navigate their learning tasks. During this period of remote learning, 3-6 learning coaches will be providing support across the school for P-2 learning communities.

Onsite supervision for year 3-6 children

Children of essential workers and vulnerable children will still be able to attend school and be supervised while accessing the same remote learning program. Where possible we encourage you to support your child to access their remote learning from home.

Confirm your child's attendance for onsite supervision (3-6 children)

You will need to confirm if your child will still be attending school during this remote learning period, and you can do this by emailing: margarethendry@ed.act.edu.au
